2. General Aim and Course Description

This is an introduction to Immanuel Kant's philosophy, through a reading of *Prolegomena to Any Future Metaphysics*. Throughout the course, we will do a close study of *Prolegomena*, attempting to 1) understand the core features of Kant's metaphysics and moral philosophy 2) critically assess and analyse the main arguments he provides for his theses 3) interpret and locate Kant's philosophy in a historical context and 4) connect some main claims in *Prolegomena* to some recent concerns in analytic metaphysics.
